Annual Report of the Committee

Introduction

Another very successful year of petanque with our membership growing from 37 to 53 members. We now have a firm proposal for our Mornington Peninsula Petanque Centre at Moorooduc Recreation Reserve, and it is expected that our terrain will be completed and ready for use in August/September 2016.

There have been several very enjoyable and successful fund-raising events, including the Bunnings Sausage Sizzle, Trivia Night, Fun and Games Night and Theme Dinners.

Membership and Promotions

Our "Come and Try Petanque" promotion at Mornington Park (15th November 2015) was not as successful as the 2014 event being held too late in the year. Although attendance was good we did not gain many new members. Our 2016 "Come and Try Petanque Day" will be held in October.

Committee Meetings

During the year 6 Committee Meetings, including a Special Committee Meeting to discuss Fund-raising, were held. These were all well attended.

Due to on-going surgery our Treasurer, Martin, resigned from his portfolio, and from the Committee. Eve took over the Treasurer role for the rest of the Financial Year. The Committee decided to reduce the work-load on the treasurer and appointed Neil Franks, to handle the book-keeping aspect. Thank you for all of your hard work Martin and Eve.

Development of MPPC

In line with our membership growth the following developments have been achieved for our Club

- We have at last received a proposal from the Shire for building of our "home" at the Moorooduc Recreation Reserve.
- Development of MPPC Website, together with Terry Cantwell and students from the Mt. Eliza Secondary College. We need to further populate the website with Content. A big thanks to Jim, Di, and Vicki.
- The Strategy Plan initially developed by Chris Nelms and me, with refinements by other Members, has been updated – for consideration of the new Committee. This is a "living document", and it is recommended that it be continuously updated as the Club develops.
- An A-Frame has been purchased for use at Club Events.

They offered us the option of building our terrain over a double tennis court at the Moorooduc Recreation Reserve.

A Request for Quotations has been issued for the building of 7 pistes and a storage shed, and it is expected that the work should be completed in the August/September.
